Pastor Ralph Rokke was born in 1951, and grew up at Strandquist, Minnesota, graduating from high school there in 1969. He attended Bemidji State College, and graduated in 1973, with a B.A. in English and German. Then he attended the Association Free Lutheran Theological Seminary, and graduated in 1976, with a B.Th. degree.

Following ordination on June 13, 1976, Pastor Rokke served a three-church parish at McIntosh and Fosston, Minnesota, for three and a half years. Then he served a parish in the inner-city of Minneapolis for sixteen and a half years. During those years, he earned an S.T.M. degree in 1989, and a D. Min. degree in 1995, both from Concordia Seminary in St. Louis, Missouri.

In 1997, Pastor Rokke was received on the roster of Ministers of Religion – Ordained of the Lutheran Church -Missouri Synod. Being new to the LCMS and needing a home church in the Minnesota South District to be eligible for a call through the district office, Pastor Rokke spoke with Pastor Bob Schultze at Mt. Hope Lutheran Church in Bloomington. Ralph and Kathi joined Mt. Hope in 1997.

While waiting for a call to full-time parish ministry, Pastor Rokke served as an adjunct professor at Concordia University in St. Paul, and briefly as assistant pastor at Trinity Lone Oak Lutheran Church in Eagan, MN.

In 1998, Pr. Rokke was called to serve as pastor at Saint James Lutheran Church in West St. Paul. He served there for nineteen years, and retired on October 31, 2017, which was the 500th anniversary of Martin Luther's 95 Theses and the Lutheran Reformation. It's an easy date for him to remember!

Ralph and Kathi Rokke were married in 1972. They have two daughters, Joyce and Shari; two sons-in-law, Greg and Hank; and six grandchildren. A seventh grandchild is expected in July, 2019.
