The Message

It was quite a week! Several things happened and as I sat down to write this message, I found myself thinking the words of Pontius Pilate; "What is truth!?" (John 18:38)

NO, I'm not having a crisis in faith, but thinking about Christianity and the LIFE OF FAITH pushed me to uttering those words. Here's what I mean...Every day I receive email after email and mailers on THE CHRISTIAN LIFE, how/what to do to teach people to live a life of faith. What to do to grow a church and on and on...

Add to that the information out there on the great and growing divide in our country. Can you be a Christian and be on a particular "side" when it comes to the heating up election? What about coronavirus? How does faith play into what I believe about COVID-19? What about RACE RELATIONS? How does my faith impact what I believe about RACE IN OUR COUNTRY? WHAT IS TRUTH?!!

Then I was reminded of these words from pastor and author *Tim Keller, We find ourselves for the first time in history where all people do not believe there is a TRUTH outside of us. At one time all believed feelings and desires inside were to be put in alignment with TRANSCENDENT TRUTH (outside).*

Now, we are being told truth is inside of us. The accepted "norms" outside of us are not reality. We need to discover truth inside. My feelings are REALITY and the world outside needs to align with them. The result is the unraveling of our social institutions. WHAT IS TRUTH?

Then on Tuesday evening when our Vision Team met, we were challenged with the questions, WHY DOES YOUR CHURCH EXIST? What is the unique VISION THE LORD HAS GIVEN MOUNT HOPE?

This all came full circle for me anyway, when I opened an email forwarded to me containing a devotion with a wonderful reminder from AW TOZIER titled, *Are We Missing the Church's Purpose?* AND THERE IT IS! THE TRUTH!! Of course, we know this! We have heard it many times, but WE NEED FREQUENT REMINDERS.

"God's purpose in all this was to use the church to display His wisdom in its rich variety to all the unseen rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. This was His eternal plan, which He carried out through Christ Jesus our Lord." (Ephesians 3:10-11 NLT)

WE KNOW THIS. JESUS IS THE WAY, THE TRUTH, THE LIFE! The church's work is to proclaim this TRUTH! Both our Scripture readings for today talk about JESUS, the Truth, God's gift of grace given because He so loved the world. *NT Wright, in writing on our Romans passage for today.* The death and resurrection of Jesus, though seldom mentioned in Romans ch. 9-11, is after all present underneath, determining the shape of the thought and argument. But in order for the mercy thereby gained to be available for all as a gift of grace rather than a privilege or right, it was necessary for all people, Jew as well as Gentile, to be shut up in the prison called 'disobedience'."

Only so could grace be grace, with all human pride being humbled, and mercy – as opposed to reward – be available to all. This is the big picture of the plan of God which Paul has finally laid before us.

Paul lays this out for Timothy very clearly, (1 Timothy 2:3-7), "For this is good and pleases God our Savior, who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.

For, there is one God and one Mediator who can reconcile God and humanity – the man Christ Jesus. He gave his life to purchase freedom for everyone. This is the message God gave to the world at just the right time. And I have been chosen as a preacher and apostle to teach the Gentiles this message about faith and truth. I'm not exaggerating – just telling the truth."

What is truth? Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life! FOR EVERYONE! It's so simple! IT IS A SIMPLE MESSAGE OF TRUTH. The world, our world, so needs this message today.

We know that there is TRUTH a Transcendent Truth, Jesus Christ, God's Son.

How do we reach what Tim Keller and many others are calling a Post-Christian world where this world is Catechizing our kids and influencing our culture?

Perhaps, we simply need to get back to the basics. It comes up frequently, but the basics of our life together are laid out in (*Acts 2:42-47*).

"All the believers devoted themselves to the apostle's teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer."

We will resume our "BACK TO THE BASICS" study in a few weeks. How are we/you doing in devotion to God's Word? Our fellowship, even if it is virtual or by phone, etc. To sharing what we have? What about our prayer life? Are we praying for the lost world? Are we praying specifically for one or two people we know who need to know Jesus?

Verse 43 offers the result of back to the basics living; "A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders." Powerful!

"And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared their money with those in need. They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity – all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people." It sounds like a rhythm of life that is being shaped by a transcendent power and authority. It is a life shaped by The Truth.

What is the result? "And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved." The Lord added. We do not do the adding, we live by the basics, living a life of devotion and focus on our Lord Jesus. He does the rest.

It would be much easier to huddle up and stay in our safe zones. But our commitment to the basics, to following Jesus calls us out. (2 Corinthians 5:14)

"Christ's love controls us. Since we believe that Christ died for all, we also believe that we have all died to our old life. He died for everyone so that those who receive His new life will no longer live for themselves. Instead, they will live for Christ, who died and was raised for them.

So, we have stopped evaluating others from a human point of view. At one time we thought of Christ merely from a human point of view. How differently we know Him now! This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone, a new life has begun!"

Our world so desperately needs the Truth. Our world (everyone) needs Jesus! NOW THAT IS THE TRUTH! AMEN
