In other words, the places we go matter. Even more so, I would argue, regular worship attendance influences and shapes our Monday through Saturday lives. Author James K.A. Smith writes,

But because I do believe that worship is the heart of discipleship – and hence that the church is at the heart of the Christian life – I also believe that for the sake of discipleship it is crucial to immerse oneself in a community of practice that exhibits the reformative potential we've been describing. Your heart is at stake.

Smith's book, You Are What You Love, describes the importance of our gathering together for worship. Essentially, the book presents the "whys" for us to not give up the habit of meeting together.

I realize that most of you reading this are going to agree and perhaps wonder, "Why are we talking about this?" It is a good reminder for all of us and it will be a big piece of our focus for fall. We are excited for and planning for *Back to Church Sunday, September 11!*

The District LWML Convention was June 16-18 in Wilmar, MN. A total of 310 people attended the convention which was truly faith-filled, inspiring, and many connections were made.

The LWML is celebrating it's 80th anniversary (1942-2022) this year. The assembly was asked to bring 80 banners relating to the Conventions theme: Rejoice in Hope. 82 banners were displayed around the convention hall.

There was a Silent Auction of 29 Baskets for bidding. These baskets raised \$2,510.00 for our Mission Goal. 5 quilts were made at the 2021 Fall Retreat. These quilts were auctioned off and raised \$825.00 for our Mission Goal. Four offerings were collected at the convention. Offering #1 Jonathan House-\$4,465.50; Offering #2 Laurel Community



School-\$3,586.37; Offering #3 2022-2024 Mission Goal-\$5,207.93; Offering #4 Camp Omega-\$4,418.38. Our Gifts from the Heart Mission Project collected 214 Welcome Home Kits, 19 comforters, 230 quilts, 789 pocket bibles, and \$2,595 in Target Gift Cards for the New Freedom Store & Halfway House at Jevohah Lutheran Church in St. Paul.
