

PRAISE - Part 2 (Part 1-see August Newsletter)

This month marks one year since I assumed responsibility for our Prayer Chain Ministry. During this time, I've come to better understand what prayer is. It has been an amazing journey in how the Lord has opened my eyes to better understand why we should pray. He has done this marvelous work after reading more than two months of devotions by Dr. Michael Youssef of Leading the Way Ministry and also Dr. Charles Stanley of In Touch Ministries. And it all started with a question I had never thought of before, "If God knows all of our needs, why do we need to pray?"

Directed back to the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus says, "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you," Matthew 7:7. Again, this does not answer the above question. So, why would Jesus tell us to ask, seek, and knock? I'd like to briefly share what I learned from my devotional time on the subject of prayer.

First: I learned prayer requires knowing God. Many may know about God, but few really get to know Him. The ability to know Him means spending time with Him in His Word, speaking and listening to Him in prayer——and that takes both time and effort.

Second: I learned that prayer requires faith in God. While it is one thing to know the Will of God, it is another thing to trust Him and wait for its fulfillment. We must continue to ask, seek, and knock. And, if we are praying according to His Will, sooner or later He will answer our prayer. Even when we feel God is not coming through, we must keep on trusting and believing He will answer.

Third: I learned that prayer truly desires that God's Will be done. Yes, it is easy to go to God with our grocery list of prayers, but do we have the desire, the longing in our heart for the Will of God. Yes, I admit there are times I may not like the Will of God, but I was reminded that God's Will is never punitive. I was reminded of His great love for us and that He always gives what is best for us, and that while our thinking is short-term, God is thinking of the future.

Putting it all together then, I was able to see these three aspects of prayer—knowledge, faith, and desire—as Jesus commanded when He said to ask, seek, and knock.

May you find grace from Him today and may He continue to richly bless your prayer life.
